

GRAND LAKES MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2
NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District (the "Board") will hold a special public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being an official meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Monday, January 29, 2024, at 11:00 a.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board meeting held on December 18, 2023;
3. Authorize preparation and submission of District information to Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts as required by Section 403.0241, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 203, Texas Local Government Code, for inclusion in the Special Purpose District Public Information Database;
4. Review and discussion of the monthly activity reports prepared by the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office and Fort Bend County Precinct 1 Constable's Office;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports; authorize the payment of invoices presented;
6. Adoption of Resolution Adopting List of Qualified Brokers Authorized to Engage in Investment Transactions;
7. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented, approval of tax refunds, and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
8. Review of Delinquent Tax Collection Attorneys' Report from Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P.; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
9. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2024, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
10. Discussion of exemptions from taxation for 2024, and adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;
11. Sales Tax Revenue Status Report;
12. Operation and Maintenance Report, including:
 - A. Monthly report;

 - F. Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same; and
 - G. Reclaimed water system and irrigation;
13. Authorize operator to provide required information to districts receiving water from the District relative to Consumer Confidence Reports (due April 1, 2024);
14. Engineer's Report, including:
- A. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for construction of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans;
 - B. Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of the District, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith, including wastewater treatment plant site permit;
 - C. Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - D. Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 related to same, including:
 - E. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes; and
 - F. Review and approval of amended Capital Improvement Plan;
15. Issuance of utility commitments and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 related to same;
16. Discussion regarding the status of the proposed development of Jason's Deli by Grand Parkway Shopping Center, Ltd., including:
- A. Status of execution of:
 - i. Utility Commitment;
 - ii. Utility Development Agreement;
 - iii. Waiver Agreement;
 - iv. Water Line easement (0.5723-acre); and
 - v. Water Meter easement (0.0022-acre);
17. Discussion of Community Projects:
- A. District Projects:
 - i. Lazy River Pool Rehabilitation Project (Petra), including:
 - 1. Status of warranty work;
 - 2. Approval of pay estimates and change orders and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 related to same; and
 - ii. Status of landscaping projects;

19. Discuss compliance with the EPA Phase II Small MS4 General Permit, including:
 - A. Review of Year-5 Annual Report;
 - B. Discussion of any training necessary under the storm water management plan; and
 - C. Approval of Sixth Amendment to Agreement for Services for Phase II Storm Water Consulting by and between the District and Storm Water Solutions, LP and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 related to same;
20. Discussion of renewal of District insurance policies and authorize solicitation of proposals for same;
21. Matters related to Directors Election to be called for May 4, 2024, including (i) memorandum regarding joint elections, and (ii) notification of Fort Bend County officials that the District intends to participate in the joint election;
22. Convene Closed Session for consultation with attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, as amended;
23. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any actions related to matters discussed in Closed Session;
24. Attorney's Report; and
25. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
